**Determination of need:** The Otselic Valley Central School District will determine the need for AIS/Rtl services based on a two step procedure. Step 1: All students at or below a median cut point between a level 2 and Level 3 (determined by the Commissioner), shall be considered for AIS (Grades 3-8 ELA and math) and Step 2 Otselic Valley CSD will apply a district-developed procedure to be applied uniformly at each grade level for determining which students shall receive AIS after the district considers student's scores on multiple measures.

**Measures to be used:** if available the NYS 3-7 ELA and math assessment scores, NWEA beginning of year benchmark results, previous or current year report card, classroom assessments, and teacher knowledge of the student. Faculty will use the above mentioned criteria to determine need of service, once a determination is made, they will notify the Director of Curriculum who will notify parents of the need for service provision.

**Description of services:** AIS/Rtl services

**Service start dates:** Once a determination has been made, the services must begin no later than the beginning of the semester following the determination of need.

**When services will be provided:** During the regular school day

**Parent notification:** Parents will be notified of the service to be provided (math, ELA, etc), quarterly progress notes to coincide with report card dates, and removal from service.

**Student exit criteria:** The provision of AIS/Rtl services may be terminated based on, updates NYS scores, student progress on benchmark assessments, mastery of grade level standards as noted on classroom assessments, teacher knowledge of student skills, and report card data.
