

NOTICE

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- PLEASE NOTIFY YOUR LOCAL ASSESSOR OR COLLECTOR IMMEDIATELY IF THERE APPEARS TO BE ERRORS OR OMISSIONS OF ANY KIND ON THIS BILL INTEREST PENALTIES CANNOT BE WAIVED AS A RESULT OF ERRORS AND/OR OMISSIONS AFTER THE INITIAL INTEREST FREE PAYMENT DATE.
- A UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE POSTMARK WILL BE USED AS DATE OF RECEIPT ON COLLECTIONS.

SENIOR CITIZENS TAX EXEMPTION:

YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR A SENIOR CITIZEN TAX EXEMPTION. CERTAIN VILLAGES, TOWNS, AND SCHOOL DISTRICTS HAVE GRANTED A 50% TAX EXEMPTION TO PERSONS 65 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER, WHO HAVE OWNED THEIR HOME FOR 12 CONSECUTIVE MONTHS, WHO OCCUPY THEIR HOME AS THEIR LEGAL RESIDENCE, USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES, AND WHO MEET CERTAIN INCOME LIMITATIONS. CONTACT YOUR LOCAL ASSESSOR FOR MORE INFORMATION.

THIRD PARTY NOTIFICATION:

IF YOU ARE AGE 65 OR OLDER, OR DISABLED AND YOU OWN AND OCCUPY A 1, 2, OR 3 FAMILY RESIDENCE, YOU MAY DESIGNATE A CONSENTING ADULT THIRD PARTY TO RECEIVE DUPLICATE COPIES OF YOUR TAX BILLS AND NOTICES OF UNPAID TAXES UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE. APPLICATION MAY BE MADE THROUGH YOUR LOCAL TAX COLLECTING OFFICER OR YOUR LOCAL ASSESSOR IN PERSON OR BY MAIL IF YOU INCLUDE WITH YOUR REQUEST A SELF-ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE.

PENALTY INFORMATION FOR COUNTY COLLECTIONS:

- **UNPAID TAXES SUBJECT TO CHENANGO COUNTY COLLECTION ARE PAYABLE BY CASH, CERTIFIED CHECK, BANK CHECK OR MONEY ORDER. PERSONAL CHECKS ARE NOT ACCEPTED.**
- PLEASE REFER TO THE FRONT OF THE BILL FOR TAX PAYMENT INFORMATION PRIOR TO COUNTY ENFORCEMENT.

CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT TAXES

TAXES REMAINING UNPAID AT THE END OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT COLLECTION PERIOD ARE TURNED OVER TO CHENANGO COUNTY IN MID NOVEMBER. THE COUNTY WILL ACCEPT PAYMENTS FOR UNPAID SCHOOL TAXES FROM THE TIME THAT THEY ARE TURNED OVER BY THE DISTRICT UNTIL THE FOURTH WEDNESDAY IN NOVEMBER. TAXES REMAINING UNPAID AFTER THIS DATE WILL BE RELEVIED ON THE JANUARY TOWN & COUNTY TAX BILL. TAXES ARE SUBJECT TO A VARIABLE DISTRICT PENALTY, 5% COUNTY PENALTY IN ADDITION TO 1% PER MONTH FROM DUE DATE.

VILLAGE TAXES

TAXES REMAINING UNPAID AT THE END OF THE VILLAGE COLLECTION PERIOD ARE TURNED OVER TO CHENANGO COUNTY IN MID NOVEMBER. THE COUNTY WILL ACCEPT PAYMENTS FOR UNPAID VILLAGE TAXES FROM THE TIME THAT THEY ARE TURNED OVER BY THE VILLAGE UNTIL THE FOURTH WEDNESDAY IN NOVEMBER. TAXES REMAINING UNPAID AFTER THIS DATE WILL BE RELEVIED ON THE JANUARY TOWN & COUNTY TAX BILL. TAXES ARE SUBJECT TO VILLAGE INTEREST, 5% COUNTY PENALTY IN ADDITION TO INTEREST OF 1% PER MONTH THEREAFTER.

TOWN AND COUNTY TAXES

TAXES REMAINING UNPAID AT THE END OF THE TOWN COLLECTION PERIOD ARE TURNED OVER TO CHENANGO COUNTY IN MID JUNE. THE COUNTY WILL ACCEPT PAYMENTS FOR UNPAID TOWN & COUNTY TAXES FROM THE TIME THAT THEY WERE TURNED OVER BY THE TOWN. TAXES REMAINING UNPAID AFTER THIS DATE ARE SUBJECT TO A 5% COUNTY PENALTY IN ADDITION TO 1% PER MONTH FROM THE ORIGINAL DUE DATE. DELINQUENT TAXES CONSISTING OF MULTIPLE YEARS OUTSTANDING MAY BE PAID IN ANNUAL INCREMENTS BEGINNING WITH THE MOST CURRENT YEAR, TO INCLUDE ALL PENALTIES, INTEREST AND RELEVIED ITEMS, HOWEVER PAYMENT PER ANNUM DOES NOT RELEASE THE PROPERTY LIEN. FAILURE TO PAY ALL TAXES DUE WILL RESULT IN LOSS OF THE PROPERTY. **FOR DELINQUENT TAX INFORMATION CALL (607) 337-1493.**
